

Additional State of California requirement!

Applicants for entertainment work permits between 14-17 years of age (age-eligible minors) must complete training in sexual harassment prevention.

Step 1: Apply or renew the Entertainment Work Permit as normal. Instructions can be found on SCCC website: <https://sccchorus.org/membership/resources>

When you print the school record form, there will now be two pages. Check Section A and write in any missing information. The school will fill out, sign and stamp Section B. Parents sign Sections C and D on the form. Section D is on the second page and pertains to the new CA law requiring minors age 14-17 to complete sexual harassment prevention training with a parent or guardian.

Step 4: Finish your work permit renewal process as normal. Be sure to ***include the certificate*** along with the school record form.
