It has step-by-step visuals and instructions which will help you to create a Crowdrise page so that you can easily receive donations for your online fundraiser. All donations are tax-deductible and go directly to SCCC. Crowdrise manages all the tax acknowledgements/receipts sent to the donors.

For any families who have "fundraising fatigue" but have the means to donate directly to the chorus, consider this your invitation to bypass the detailed instructions and simply click the red "donate" button on the main page. However, it would behoove you to go through the steps and set up a fundraiser in your child's name and donate there, as then the chorister will be eligible for the various incentives described further below.
